- **Why organize?** – Rooted in the history, traditions, and values of our faith, labour and community organizations.
- **Fundamental organizing skills** – Individual relational meetings, listening sessions, power analysis, group research, public action and negotiations.
- **Strengthening our institutions** – Increase member engagement and re-energize a sense of relevance and purpose by developing internal cultures that are relational, reflective and action-oriented.
- **Making meaningful change** – Conduct effective campaigns to bring about significant change in areas like living incomes, housing and mental health - exercising “power with” to create a fairer and just Edmonton.
